Confederate Section in Northeast section	As many as 250 Confederate casualties were buried in a mass grave along the back wall after the Battle of Williamsburg on 5 May 1862. The section is marked by a large granite spire with crossed Battle flags and the dates 1861-1865. There is also a granite threshold inscribed "1861 Our Confederate Dead 1865." There are several small sandstone markers with now almost illegible names and "CV" inscribed on them:

Bucktrout Ledger	The Daybook and Ledger of Richard Manning Bucktrout, local cabinetmaker and undertaker, is archived at Swem Library, College of William and Mary, and may be searched at: http://swem.wm.edu/archives/collections/bucktrout . Bucktrout buried about 225 Confederate troops from 1861 up until the Battle of Williamsburg. His records include name, death date, state of origin, regiment, row and grave number. Today, there is no indication of how the rows were laid out, but the Ledger is helpful in determining names of those interred in the Confederate section.
